#### Announcements

**Heavenly Food Pantry** continues to operate monthly on the  $2^{nd}$  Monday ~ 5:30-7:30pm and  $4^{th}$  Thursday ~ 2-6pm. The next Pantry date is Thursday, April 23<sup>rd</sup>.

<u>Safely receiving food</u>: Due to current health directives, the shopping process will be modified, and food will be delivered to vehicles in the Church parking lot. Clients will stay in their vehicles, where a volunteer will gather family information and bagged food will be placed in car trunks. This way, exposure will be strictly limited for both clients and volunteers.

<u>Donations</u>: The Pantry's most needed items are baked beans, tomato soup, chicken noodle soup, corn, peas, bar soap, and dish soap.

<u>Volunteers:</u> We are recruiting volunteers for *Thursday, April 23<sup>rd</sup>*. 10-12pm to pre-bag produce, 1:30-4 pm distribute food (16 and older); 4-6:15 pm distribute food (16 and older). **Please wear face masks and adhere to other CDC guidelines.**

<u>Pledge Payments:</u> In these challenging times, we know that many folks are dealing with financial uncertainty and hardship and taking care of yourself and your family is the top priority. So, this message is intended for those who are <u>not</u> facing a financial hardship right now. IF (and only if) you can help, your continued pledge payments - for the annual stewardship drive and for the capital campaign - can play a key role in helping First Church weather this storm.
