#### PALMS

If you would like to come and get your palm so you have them for worship this week [Laurie will be folding them into crosses for the Children's Message], they will be all ready for you to pick up beginning on Friday noon by the Church Street entrance in a big colored tub. Please do not congregate as you pick them up and take one per person for each member of your family. Naturally, try to only touch the ones you will be taking.

### **COMMUNION**

We will continue to have communion on the first Sunday of each month but will do so differently due to our service being live streamed. Instead of having the bread and juice provided, we ask that EVERYONE BRING THEIR OWN bread and juice or its equivalent. Some might bring crackers and water, others oreos and cokes.....it is not the substance that matters but the way in which you use the substance to remember Jesus, the Last Supper and God's love for you.
