If you take a tag from the tree at church, please secure the tag to your wrapped gift. If you select a gift from the Sign-Up Genius, you will need to create your own tag. It should include the identifying number of the gift – ex: 11A - and the age and gender of the child. This will allow the family to know which gift goes to each of their children.

One last request. If you choose to give a gift card, please place it in a small wrapped box or bag with the tag attached. Gift cards can easily be misplaced among all of the larger gifts. This makes it easier for us to keep track of them.
